Micky and clergy will continue to reach out to the 20 families who we have not heard from. JRC plans to make the final payment on the building loan in January 2023, pending a few members satisfying substantial commitments. JRC has about \$239,983 in Employee Retention Credit ("ERC") funds to budget for this fiscal year. A motion was passed to adjust the Fiscal Year 2023 budget to allow \$68,000 of the remaining ERC funds to be used for immediate needed repairs and expenditures, with the remaining funds of approximately \$171,000 to be placed in a reserve fund with the JRC Foundation in a non-restricted account, which will, if possible, be subject to the direct control of the JRC Board.
