*My mother defeated Hitler. She was living in Chozov, Poland,
just completed Gymnasium, when WWII began. She stayed
alive in 5 years at work camps. She stayed alive during a long
march to death camps toward the end of the war. She arrived
at Bergen-Belsen a day before all the non-Jewish political
prisoners were to be evacuated. That same day murders of all
the Jews was supposed to begin. But she and her 3 friends were
evacuated with the political prisoners, Hitler died and they lived
40, 50, 60 more years.*

*My father also defeated Hitler. He was a kosher butcher,
married with 3 children, living in Warsaw, Poland. He served in
the military when Germany and Poland went to war. What he
saw so horrified him that when he returned home after Poland
had surrendered, he packed everything, brought his family to
the train and bought tickets for somewhere in Russia. When
the train arrived at the Russian border it was stopped. Stalin
and Hitler were allies. Hitler had told Stalin to stop all trains
trying to escape from Poland. The other Jewish passengers left
the train, milled about. My Father walked a distance from the
Border guards, took the barbed wire in his hands and pulled it
apart. Had a round scar below his knee as a memento. Then
everyone on the train flowed into Russia, the Border Guards did
not try to stop them, and they were all safe for one more day.*
