## For approximately 150 guests

## For the Bimah (during the service)

- 1 small challah, unsliced
- JRC will provide challah tray, cover and Kiddush cup with juice/wine

# For the Kiddush (after the service)

- Grape Juice 2-3 large bottles
- Challah 2-3 large loaves, cut in bite-size squares
- Small Plastic Cups (approx. 2.5 oz.)
- Napkins
- Optional: cookies, doilies, plant/flowers for decoration

## For a standard Kiddush in the Lobby, JRC Provides

- 2 Long Tables
- · Table linens
- Trays/Baskets/Pitchers

### You Provide

- Dishes/Glassware/Silverware
- Paper Goods (including Cups)
- Coffee/Tea/Sugar/Cream
- Challah/Juice/Wine

Absolutely no glitter is to be used

# **Instructions for Kiddush Set-Up**

- The JRC Custodian will set up tables in the lobby and clean the space after the kiddush everything else is the family's responsibility
- Appoint at least 2 people to set-up Kiddush; these can be family/friends or hired help
- Trays, baskets and pitchers are available in the kitchen
- Plan on 30-45 minutes set-up time (depending on number of guests)
